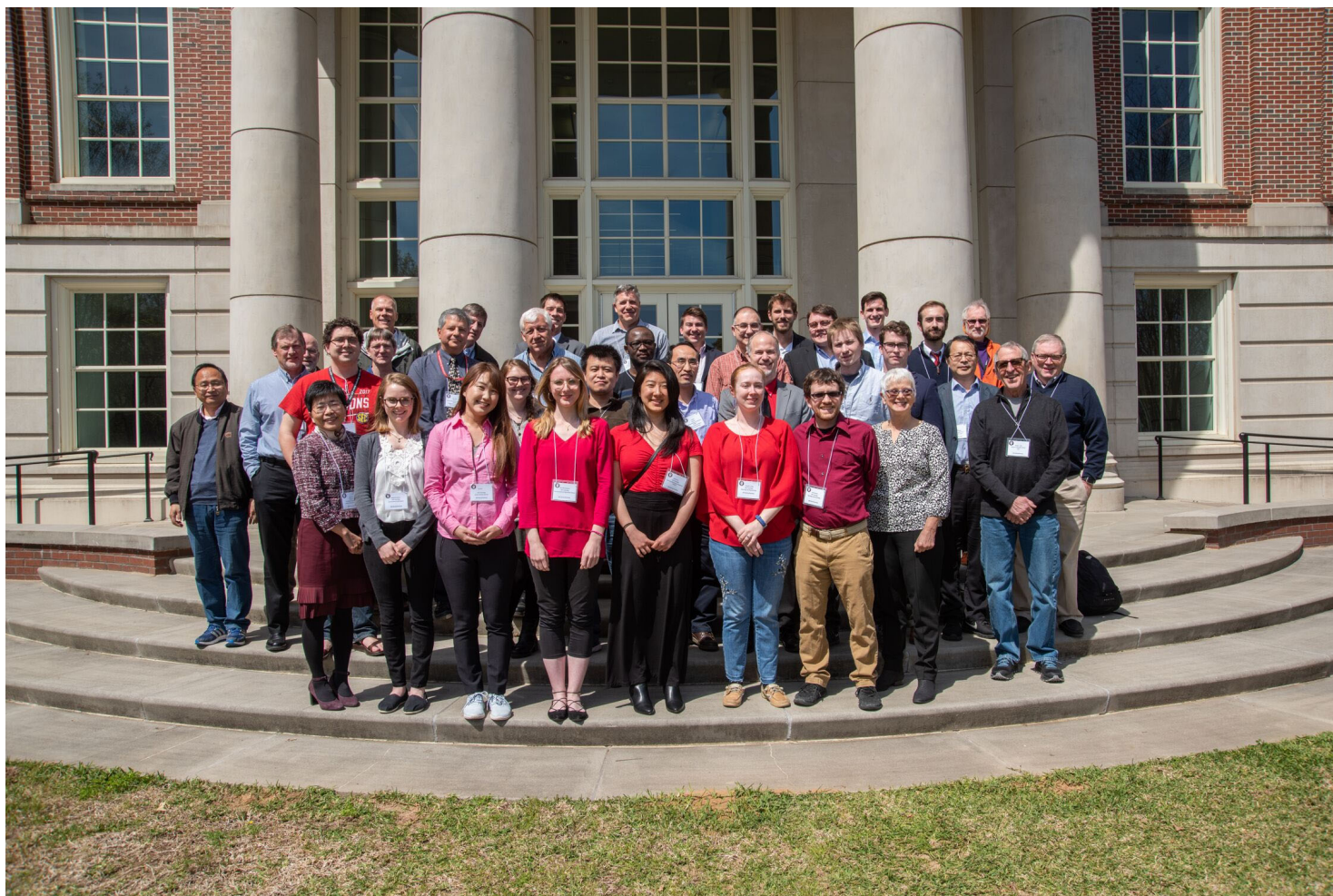

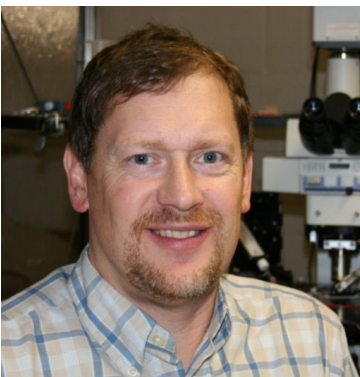
Greetings fellow ITP colleagues,

Time has passed quickly since our last issue of the Interdisciplinary Toxicology Program newsletter was disseminated in the Summer of 2018! As with any active, multifaceted program, there are a number of events, accomplishments and changes that have occurred over the past 18 months so please take a moment and look through this issue of our newsletter. Our Welcome Back retreat events in the Fall held at Flinchum's Phoenix have been a pleasant way to reconnect ITP students & faculty, welcome new program participants, and enjoy some good food! The 2019 ITP Spring Retreat included keynote speakers Dr. Chris Vulpe from the University of Florida and our own Dr. Marsha Black from University of Georgia. Dr. Black has recently retired from the Department of Environmental Health Sciences and we certainly thank her for her many contributions to the ITP and wish her well in the years to come!

ITP faculty and students have represented UGA at several regional and national toxicology meetings over the past year.
